Dear Parents/Carers

As Year 5 Camp is nearly upon us, may I take this opportunity to give you some details.

Please may I remind you that all payments should have been received by Tuesday 2nd May unless specific arrangements have been agreed. A revised itinerary, suggested kit list are overleaf and you will see below a 'Permission to administer Calpol' reply slip which will need to be returned as soon as possible so that we can finalise arrangements and process information for Porthpean. We will not be allowed to take your child to camp unless these letters have been returned.

Children will need to meet on Wednesday morning 21st June at the normal time, on the main playground (in the hall if wet), where they will be registered and taken to the coaches. We aim to leave by 9.00am.

The children will have been asked to pack their lunch, drink, waterproof coat, sun cream and sun hat into a small day sack/bag which they will keep with them on the coach. This will help us to start our activities quickly when we arrive at Porthpean.

Any medication needs to be in a named container, with instructions placed inside. This needs to be given to the classteacher on Monday 19th June or Tuesday 20th June.
